

Online Nursing Classes - Guide 2023

Nursing school is challenging and it's easy to fall behind. Failing a class doesn't define you or restrict your potential as a nurse.

Health Assessment and Promotion

Students find it helpful to practice physical assessments on friends or family members and to participate in study groups to test their skills and knowledge.

Effective communication is another necessary skill that nurses must have in order to ace this class. It's helpful to practice verbal and nonverbal communication techniques regularly. Some students also find it helpful to join a support group for nursing students, as they can share tips and encouragement.

Anatomy and Physiology

Anatomy and Physiology are two of the more difficult nursing classes, but they also play an important role in patient care. Anatomy is the scientific study of the body's structures and how they fit together. It focuses on what organs look like and where they are located, along with the substance they secrete and their general purposes.

Physiology is the study of how those organs function, which requires an understanding of chemistry and physics. It explains the normal processes of the body and what happens when the body's systems malfunction.

Many nursing students find the class challenging because of its large amount of medical and scientific terminology, which can lead to stress and unsatisfactory grades. Developing good organizational skills and practicing verbal communication techniques will help you excel in this course. It is also important to maintain a healthy diet as nursing school can be demanding on your physical health. Medical Terminology

The linguistic foundation for the entire healthcare system, medical terminology introduces you to the unique way that words are constructed as a language. The combining of word roots, prefixes and suffixes creates unique medical terms that describe the various aspects of a disease or specific location on the body. For nurses, a fluency in medical terminology is essential. Passing this class can be a challenge, especially for new nursing students. Pharmacology
